 - ☐ 3 hours simulated instrument training (night and hood time may not be combined)
 - ☐ 3 hours in preparation for practical in 2 calendar months preceding the month of application
- ☐ Solo Flight 10 hours
 - ☐ 5 hours cross country (>50 nm)*
 - ☐ Long cross country >150 nm 3 landings. One segment >50 nm*
 - ☐ 3 takeoff and landing to full stop at airport with operating tower
