

Checkride Checklist

- ☐ Scenario reviewed and all assignments complete. Weight and balances for scenario, Takeoff and landing distance for scenario, weight and balance for checkride, takeoff and landing distance for checkride.
- ☐ Aircraft maintenance logs reviewed and in possession. We will need these logs to begin the checkride. Pictures of log pages are not acceptable.
- ☐ Current charts, paper or electronic. If using an EFB you are required to have a backup for IFR operations.
- ☐ Current Pilot certificate, medical, valid photo ID.
- ☐ Aircraft documents on board. This includes any STC or supplements.
- ☐ Endorsements in logbook or printed (if using an electronic logbook).
- ☐ All required VFR or IFR equipment (if IFR checkride) must be operational.
- ☐ Logbook totaled in pen. Except last page where total in pencil is acceptable. Please make sure your name is on the logbook and your signature is on every log page.
- ☐ Tab important milestones for required experience. For example required night cross country (PPL), TAA aircraft hours (CPL).
- ☐ Dress code is business casual.
- ☐ Checkride fee (no personal checks or credit cards)
